The City of Tumwater, along with the Thurston Regional Planning Council (TRPC), is developing a community vision to revitalize and rejuvenate this former iconic site to the center of community pride and activity that it once represented.

Over 125 residents met last month to kick off the visioning process. The Lorig team, consultants to the City and TRPC, provided preliminary information about the site, and participants brainstormed possible uses for three subareas: The Knoll, The Valley, and the Bluff.

At **this second and final community meeting for the process**, we will be blending your visions with the consultant's evaluation of the site, the buildings, and the market. You will have an opportunity to view possible short and long term scenarios, and express your priorities for the future of this extraordinary site.
