Please join us Tuesday, May 31st at the Tumwater Valley Lodge to envision the future for the former Olympia Brewery Site. The City of Tumwater, together with the Thurston Regional Planning Council (TRPC), is excited to announce a Community Visioning Project for the former Olympia Brewery properties. Our goal is to develop a community vision to revitalize and rejuvenate this former iconic site to the center of community pride and activity that it once represented.

South sound community members have vivid memories of the Brewery and its historic significance to our community. In 1999 Pabst Tumwater Brewery sold to Miller Brewing Company who closed the plant in 2003. Since then we have watched the property deteriorate with multiple grassroots efforts to spearhead new development.

We want to hear your vision for the future of the Brewery properties and provide the opportunity for you to hear from Lorig Associates, consultants to the City and TRPC, about their evaluation of the site, the buildings and the market. This public meeting will be structured to blend your vision with the research, evaluation, findings and possibilities offered by the Lorig team.
