2. Washington Restoration Framework (Quinn Butler)	<p>Quinn Butler shared an overview of the Washington Restoration Framework. The framework provides a structure for communities in Washington to efficiently recover after a disaster, and is flexible and scalable to each disaster. This framework emphasizes local authority and works to build relationships and recovery capability prior to disasters.</p> <p>Members asked questions about potential funding sources for recovery planning and whether state agencies should be involved in local planning.</p>
3. Disaster Recovery Council Charter	<p>Paul Brewster presented the draft charter for the Disaster Recovery Council, and members confirmed that the charter accurately represented the purpose, norms, and procedures for the DRC.</p> <p>Motion by Brian Hurley to approve the DRC charter with an amendment that meetings are open to the public.</p>
4. Work Plan and Priorities	Paul Brewster presented an overview of the 2022 work program for the DRC. The work program includes drafting Recovery Support Functions, establishing a governance structure for recovery, and documenting recommendations to continue the effort.
