2. Recovery Support Function Focus Group and Survey Results	<p>Paul Brewster provided an overview of the feedback received at the stakeholder focus groups held in early May. The focus groups brought together Infrastructure & Utility, Natural Resource, and Cultural & Historic Resource stakeholders to discuss existing networks that could be used as RSF subcommittees, potential leads, and recovery priorities.</p> <p>The focus group meeting recordings will be sent via email with the meeting summary notes.</p>
3. Draft Recovery Support Functions	Brewster presented draft Recovery Support Functions for the three new RSFs. These drafts include supporting organizations, scopes, objectives, pre- and post disaster tasks, and staffing recommendations for each RSF. The DRC members will have approximately two weeks to review the drafts and provide feedback, and the drafts will then be distributed to the stakeholder groups for comments.
