Today's Meeting:

- Stakeholders will use the screening criteria below to evaluate actions within the **Plants & Animals**, **Drought & Water Use**, and **Wildfire & Extreme Heat** thematic groups.
- QUESTION:** Stakeholders have found it difficult to answer the “Equity” question below, so should it be removed as a criterion?

Criteria		Answer Range
Magnitude:	How many risks does this action address?	<i>One [1], Few [2-5], Many [6+]</i>
Effectiveness:	Is this action a long-term solution (i.e., durable)?	<i>Yes or No</i>
	To what degree would this action reduce the risk(s)?	<i>High, Medium, or Low</i>
	Is this action already being taken?	<i>Yes or No</i>
Side-effects:	Would this action have negative effects on other goals?	<i>Yes or No</i>
	Would this action have positive effects on other goals?	<i>Yes or No</i>
Equity:	Would the costs and benefits of this action be shared equally?	<i>Yes or No</i>

Next Steps:

- On May 11, (*Meeting 10*), the project team will present stakeholders a full list of all actions that have been revised and evaluated, to date.
 - The project team also will elicit stakeholder feedback on proposed numeric weighting of the screening criteria.
 - Finally, if necessary, stakeholders will use the screening criteria to evaluate new or revised actions based on ideas from the April 17 community forum and online survey
 - Respondents may complete the survey through May 8.
- On June 28 (*Meeting 11*), the project team will present a prioritized list of the actions and ask stakeholders to select three actions for Earth Economics’ benefit-cost analyses.
 - Stakeholders also will select the timeline, lead(s) and partner(s) for actions. If needed, the stakeholders will meet again in July to complete this work.
 - Currently, no meeting is scheduled for July or August.
- In September (*Meeting 12*), Earth Economics will present stakeholders its benefit-cost analyses.
 - The project team also will present stakeholders an update on the draft plan’s development.
