




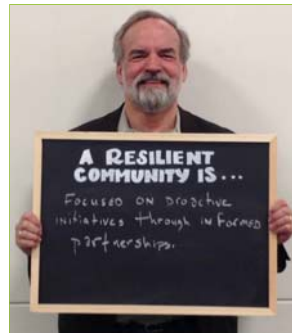

Public Outreach

- ▶ **Met with *The Olympian* editorial board**
 - ▶ Published editorial on Sunday, April 7
- ▶ **Presented to 15 Community Groups**
 - ▶ Nisqually River Council, South Thurston Economic Development Initiative (STEDI), Sierra Club, Thurston County Fire Chiefs Association, etc.
- ▶ **Hosted Community Forum**
 - ▶ Hosted April 17 (*right*)
- ▶ **Posted Online Survey**
 - ▶ Closed May 8
- ▶ **Promoted project online**
 - ▶ Via video, e-mail, social media
- ▶ **Reached 50,000+ people, collectively**



Action Plan

- ▶ **May & June**
 - ▶ Revised draft actions and evaluated for durability, effectiveness, etc.
- ▶ **July**
 - ▶ Selected 25 priority actions
- ▶ **August**
 - ▶ Elicited and incorporated input from actions leads and partners
- ▶ **September**
 - ▶ Revised actions as needed
 - ▶ Present BCAs of plan actions
