SUBJECT: 2018 Legislative Session

PURPOSE

To review the priority issues for the 2018 state Legislative Session.

Summary:

- Each year, the Regional Council decides on important regional issues to bring to our State Legislative delegation and other members of the Legislature.
- Legislators prefer a concise list of issues and specific requests.
- At its December 1 meeting, the Council agreed with the priorities issues, recognizing that throughout the session, issues may arise that also demand attention.
