PURPOSE

TRPC staff will present a report that assesses the implementation status of the Sustainable Thurston plan’s 350-plus actions.

Summary:

- TRPC adopted Sustainable Thurston’s flagship plan, “Creating Places—Preserving Spaces,” in December 2013.
- Over the ensuing five years TRPC and its community partners have implemented the plan in many ways.
- During the February 2019 meeting, TRPC staff reviewed Sustainable Thurston’s purpose, vision, goals, and planning process and progress towards meeting the priority goals and targets.
- During the March 2019 meeting, staff will discuss a new five-year implementation assessment report that provides additional detail about how the plan is being implemented.
