	<b>Jan - Jun</b>	Large-scale recruiting for area census offices and address canvassing
	<b>Beginning in Jan</b>	Census Bureau launches partnership activities
	<b>Jan - Sept</b>	Additional complete count committees launch and develop strategies and work plans
	<b>Jun - Sept</b>	Open additional area census offices in Everett, Olympia, Spokane, and Tacoma
	<b>Aug - Oct</b>	Address canvassing
	<b>Sept - Feb 2020</b>	Large-scale recruiting for the 2020 field operations
<b>2020</b>	<b>Jan</b>	Complete count committees begin community organization mobilization
	<b>Jan</b>	2020 Census advertising campaign begins
	<b>Mar - early Apr</b>	Complete count committees encouraging self-response
	<b>Mar 12-20</b>	Mailing #1 sent to homes
	<b>Mar 16-24</b>	Mailing #2 sent to non-respondents
	<b>Mar</b>	Service-based count begins (for non-permanent locations like RV parks and campgrounds, tent cities, marinas, hotels)
	<b>Mar</b>	Group quarters count begins (for those living in group quarters like dorms, nursing homes, etc. and for the homeless)
	<b>Apr 1</b>	CENSUS DAY
	<b>Early Apr - Late Jul</b>	Non-response follow-up (NRFU)
	<b>Early Apr - Late Jul</b>	Complete count committees encouraging cooperation with counters
	<b>Apr 8-16</b>	Mailing #4 - letter & paper questionnaire sent to those who have not yet responded
	<b>Apr 20-27</b>	Mailing #5 - It's not too late! postcard
	<b>Dec 31</b>	Apportionment counts to the President
<b>2021</b>	<b>Mar 31</b>	Redistricting counts to the states
