SUBJECT: Update on Important Transportation Planning Projects

PURPOSE

Ensure Policy Board members are aware of key planning initiatives underway or upcoming in the state.

Summary:

- The Washington State Legislature’s Joint Transportation Committee (JTC) commissioned a study to identify transportation priorities state-wide for the next 10 years. Executive Director Daily is representing the Regional Transportation Planning Organizations (RTPOs) on the advisory committee for that effort.
- Staff proposes that the TPB and Council formulate a ranked list of our region’s top transportation improvement priorities for the state system.
- WSDOT and TRPCs planning work for I-5 from Mounts Road through Tumwater is progressing nicely. By years’ end we will have modeled all congestion relief strategy scenarios, and the Nisqually Indian Tribe is scheduled to be finished with the hydraulic modeling and habitat assessment work. We need representatives to attend the upcoming Executive Team meetings to ensure we have all jurisdictions’ input.
