SUBJECT: 2020 Call for Projects Process

PURPOSE

To continue the discussion on the TRPC 2020 Federal Transportation Funding Call for Projects Process.

Summary:

- In 2020 TRPC will issue a Call for Projects to award approximately \$8 million Surface Transportation Block Grant funding and approximately \$900,000 each for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program and Transportation Alternative grants.
- In late November TRPC learned the region will likely receive nearly \$883,000 additional funds—Federal Highway Administration funds sanctioned from states that did not meet their 2019 Federal Fiscal Year obligation target.
- Staff will brief the Transportation Policy Board (TPB) about the new funds and possible implications for TRPC’s federal funding processes.
- The TPB will continue the discussion from November 13 to provide input on: 1) 2020 Call for Projects funding set aside; 2) Programming contingency projects to meet obligation targets; and 3) New questions to aid project selection.

REQUESTED ACTION

Forward 2020 Call for Projects Process Recommendations to TRPC on:

1. Establishing funding set asides
2. Soliciting contingency projects to support the region’s obligation target
3. New questions to aid project selection
