SUBJECT: 2020 Legislative Session

PURPOSE

To finalize the 2020 TRPC Legislative Priorities.

Summary:

- Each year, the Regional Council prioritizes important regional issues to bring to our 2nd, 20th, 22nd, and 35th district State Legislative delegation and other members of the Legislature.
- The Council and Policy Board have developed a draft list of priorities. The Council will view and respond to the final list.
- The passage of I-976 is a game-changer and locals may want to consider the way they had planned to address transportation programs and projects. For example, the action on the initiative may result in loss of funding for programs such as rural Transit (rT), so likely want to emphasize continued funding for rT.
- We are scheduling TPB meetings with our delegation now and will continue to do so as we move closer to session.
