- Preserve & Maintain the Multimodal System & Complete Current Projects



Priority Issues Shared Revenue

- Equitably Share Liquor & Marijuana Revenues
- Fully Fund Local Options - for transportation, environment, economic development, homelessness & affordable housing
- Fully Fund Planning



Priority Issues Housing & Homelessness

Provide state funding and policy to support people who are homeless, at risk for homelessness, and seeking affordable housing.



Priority Issues Environment

- Plastics & PFOs/PFAs (Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl substances) – Need state and federal Assistance for clean up
- Provide funding and collaborate on policy that supports local and regional Climate Plans.
