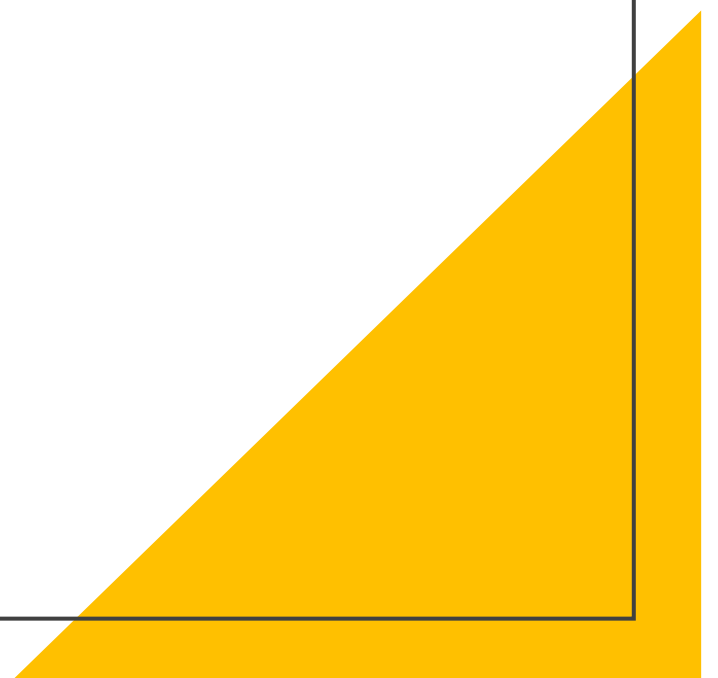

Legislative Priorities Update

HB 1280	Electrification of State Funded Buildings	✓	In Senate Rules
HB 1766	Clean Heat Act	✗	Did not pass out of House committee
HB 1770	Strengthening energy codes (residential reach code)	✓	Significantly amended, but still includes reach code option
SB 5722	Benchmarking for multifamily and commercial buildings 20,000-50,000 sq ft	✓	In House Appropriations
SSB 5974	Move Ahead WA Transportation Package	✓	Passed the Senate and on second reading in House
SB 5312	Transit-oriented development grants	✗	Passed Senate, but did not pass out of House committee
SB 5633/ HB 1895	Keep Washington Green Act	✗	Did not pass out of either committee

Action G5.5 Legislative Agenda

- **G5.5 – legislative agenda:** Prioritize climate mitigation policy in the municipalities’ legislative agenda each year.
